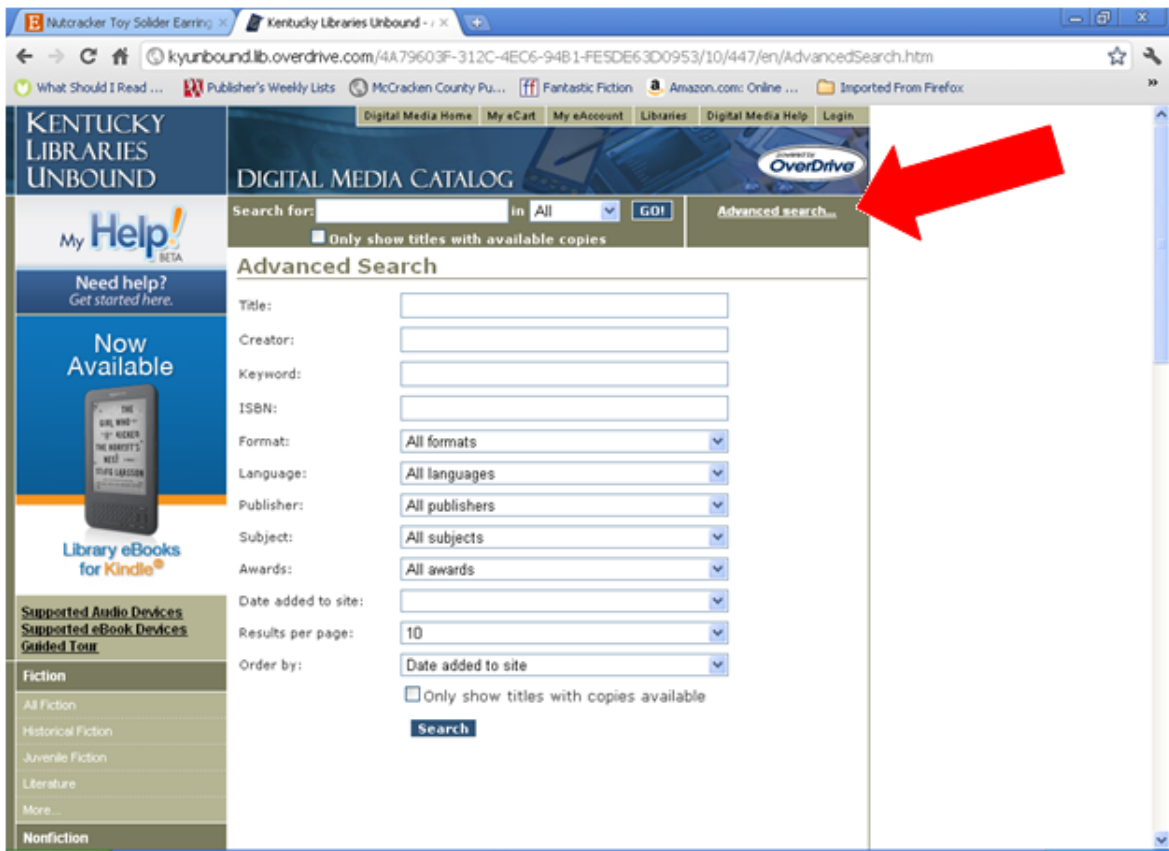


HOW TO GET A LIBRARY EBOOK ON YOUR KINDLE

1. Go to Library website: www.mclib.net. Click on “Kentucky Unbound”. Or you can go directly to www.kyunbound.lib.overdrive.com
2. To see the Kindle books we have, click “Advanced Search” at the top of the screen.



3. Under the Format list, choose “Kindle Book”
If you check the box next to “Only show titles with copies available”, it will show the copies you can check out right now, otherwise it will show every title we have (you may have to page through a lot of waiting-list items to find something to check out now)
Click Search.

HOW TO GET A LIBRARY EBOOK ON YOUR KINDLE

- Once you find the book you want, click “Add to eCart” next to the Kindle Book link.

13. Choose which Kindle you want the book sent to, or choose to transfer via computer if you don't have access to WiFi.

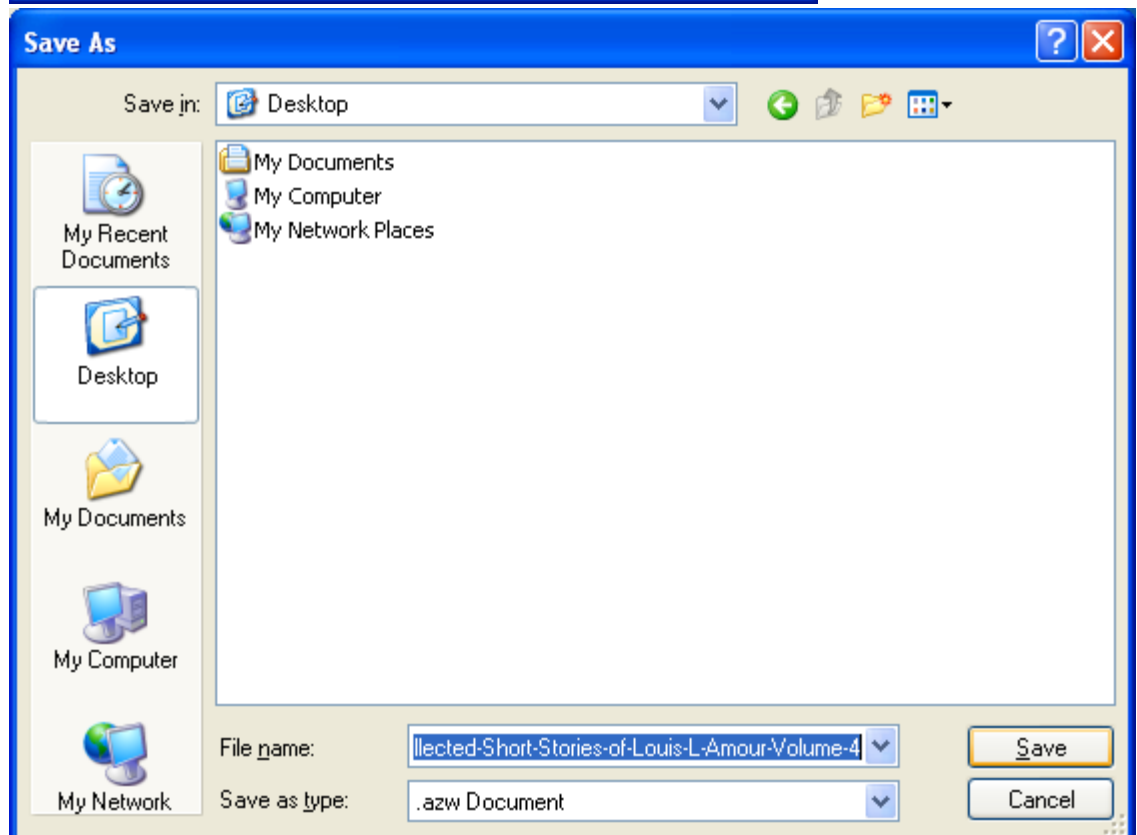
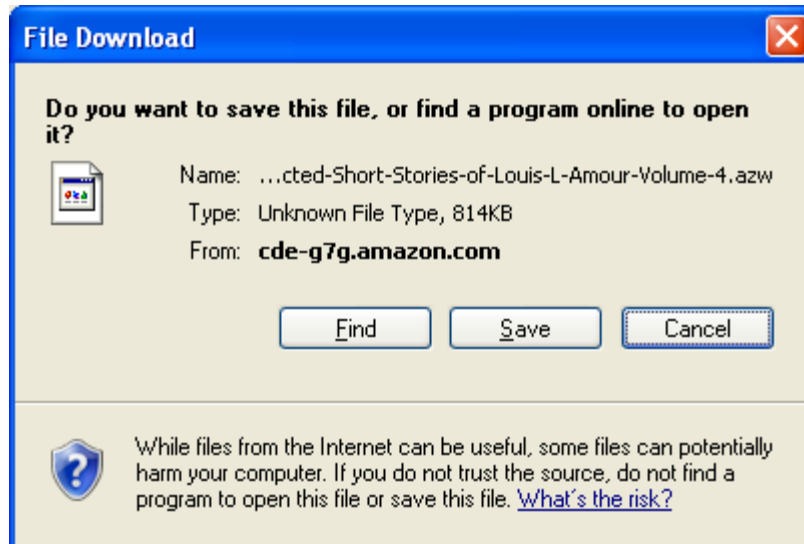
Click “Continue.”

If you're transferring via USB Cable:

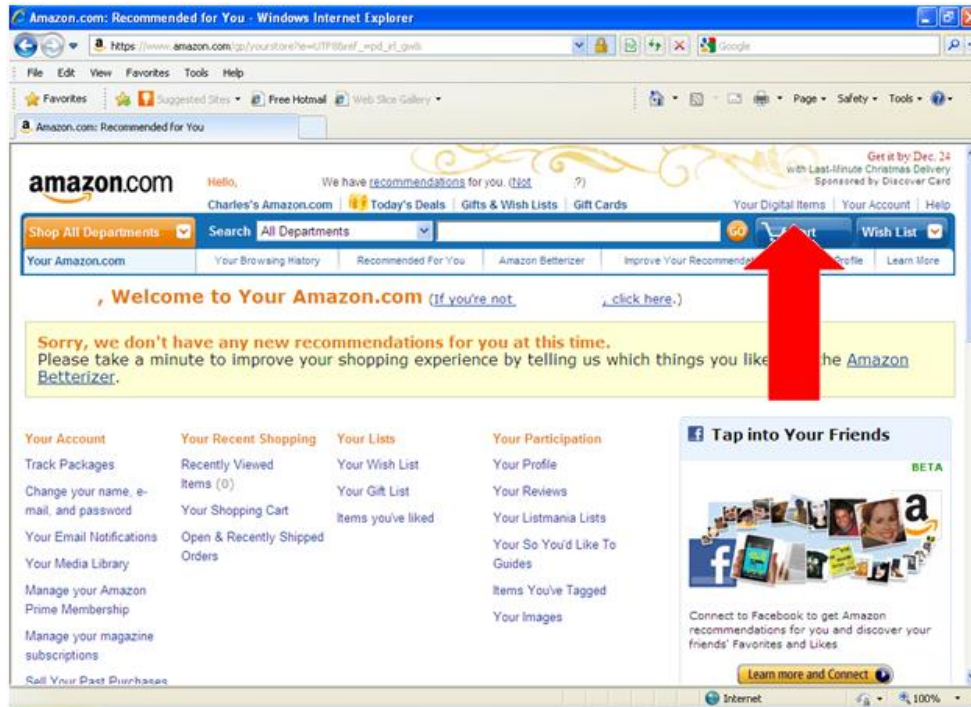
Click "Download Now" the book will be downloaded to your computer (Recommend saving to your desktop to make it easier to find later). Click "Save"



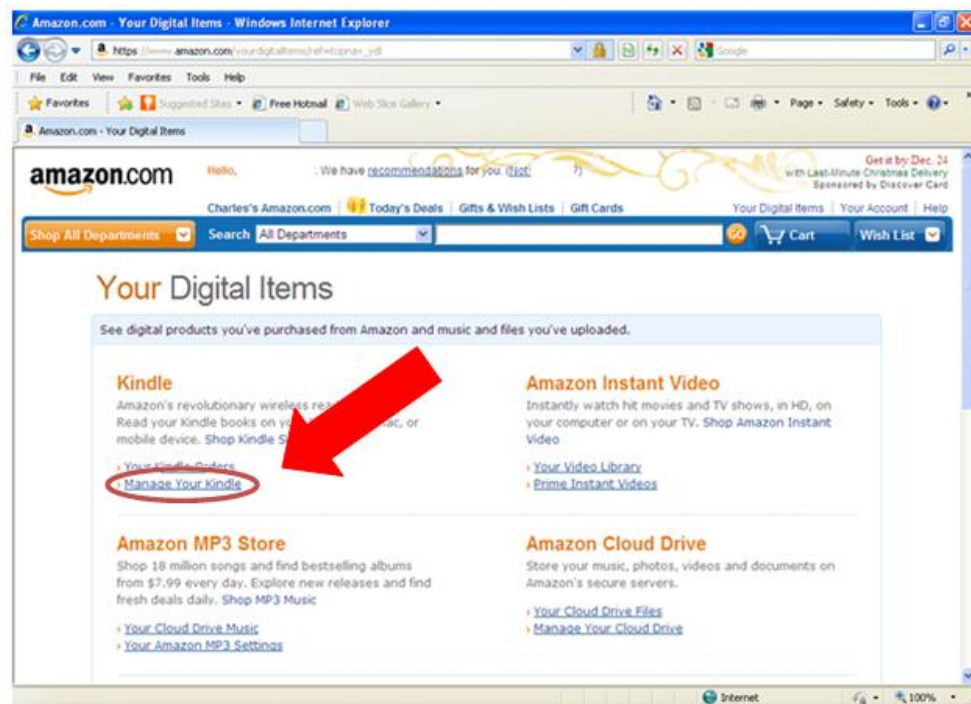
Open "My Computer". If your Kindle is plugged in, you'll see it listed. Drag the ebook from the desktop to your Kindle.

HOW TO GET A LIBRARY EBOOK ON YOUR KINDLE

1. To return or remove a book from your Kindle, go to Amazon.com. Click “Sign In” at the top of the screen.
2. Enter your email and password.
3. Click on “Your Digital Items”

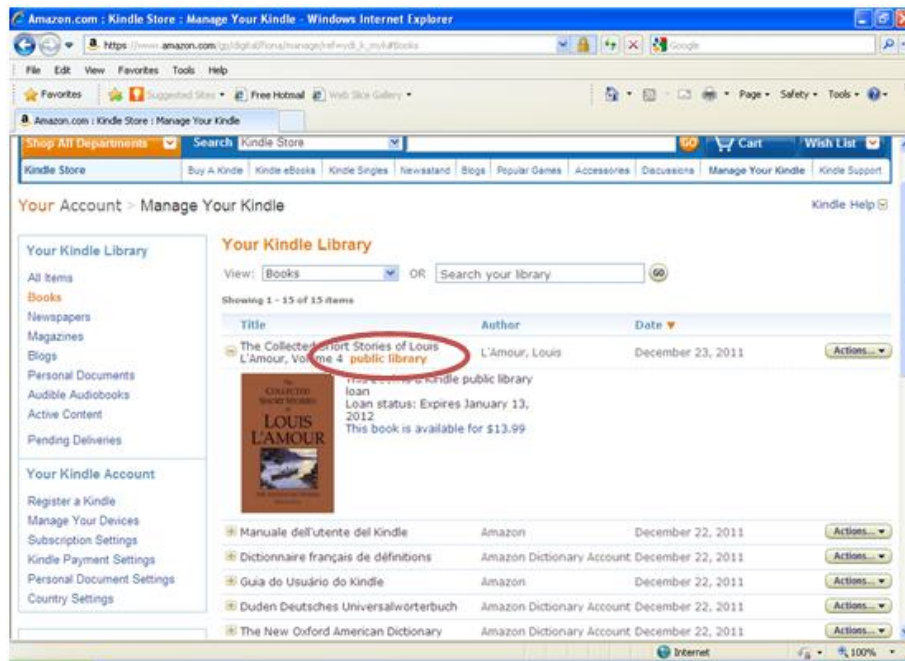


4. Click “Manage your Kindle”

5. Your Library books will be indicated “public library”



6. From the “Actions” menu on the right, you can choose to re download and transfer via USB or return the book early. (Once the book has expired or you’ve returned it, you can also choose to Delete the book from your reading history)
