Mercy Health - Lourdes Hospital is making it easy to get your flu shot. Flu vaccines have prevented millions of illnesses, flu-related doctor's visits, and hospitalizations. Mercy Health will offer free flu vaccines on the following date:

Flu vaccines are available at no cost. Offered first come, first serve, while supplies last. No insurance or pre-registration is required. Vaccinations are available to anyone at least nine years old and will be administered by Mercy Health or WKCTC. Minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
